Films are screened in their original theatrical 35mm formats using standard projection (i.e. not IMAX or IMAX digital re-mastering); the image fills approximately one third of the screen, making it one of the biggest pictures in London. As the auditorium is designed as a sound studio, sound quality is excellent. The BFI IMAX, a 485-seater auditorium two minutes from Waterloo station, offers a perfect view from steeply raked seats. Alcoholic drinks along with snacks, sweets and soft drinks are available to buy.

The After Dark programme changes regularly and customers are advised to check local listings information for details. Tickets prices are: Adults £8.50, Concessions £6.25
