

Two Cars, One Night**Transcript of the dialogue****Romeo**

Imitates the noises of a car and mimics driving.

Eddie

That girl's looking at us.

Romeo

Having a good joke?

Hey, don't look over here, your ugly face might damage my paintwork.

Romeo

Aarrghhhh!

Romeo (mimicking a police officer)

Do you know why I pulled you over miss? Probably can't even drive anywhere.

Holly

As if you can, Pig!

Romeo

Yes. I'm driving us home.

Holly

Whatever.

Romeo

Yes, I'm allowed.

Holly

Doubt it.

Romeo

Blah blah, cos our olds are gonna be wasted. *(He turns to his brother.)* Hey Ed, Eddie, Ed, I'm driving us home, hey bro?

Eddie *Grumbles a no.*

Romeo

Yeah, you don't know. *(Mumbles to himself.)* He doesn't know. *(to Holly)* So what's your handle, girl?

Holly

Holly.

Romeo

Holly? That's your first name. Are you rich or something?

Holly

Romeo

Romeo.

Holly laughs.

Romeo

Shut up, it's not funny.

Holly *(pointing at Eddie)*

(to Eddie) Hey bro! You're gonna be a lawyer hey?

Eddie

Yeah.

Romeo

You're allowed to be a gay when you're a lawyer, hey? You should be alright, hey bro?

A sports car drives past, Romeo follows it with his eyes.

Romeo

... Sweet as ...

Holly

How old are you, then?

Romeo

Er ... 16.

Holly

As if.

Romeo

Yes sir, yes I'm 16, hey bro?

Eddie

He's nine.

Romeo *(whispering and winking)*

No I'm 16 ... remember?

Eddie

Shut up man I'm reading.

Romeo

He's really a gay, hey, alright.

(to Eddie) Hey bro, what are you reading? A book, hey? What is it about, bro?

Eddie

Crazy Horse

Romeo

Holly

Holly
