



HOW TO PRIORITY BOOK TICKETS

Priority booking for BFI Southbank opens at 11:30 by all methods. Unless otherwise stated, Member priority opens on the first Tuesday of the preceding month and Champion extra priority opens 24 hours ahead. For the best chance of getting the tickets you want, we recommend that you book online if possible.

Online **BFI Southbank:** log in at bfi.org.uk/myaccount

Select My Account on the toolbar and log in with your email address (username) and password. Always log in before you start booking to access your online booking privileges including priority booking, discounted Member tickets and booking fee exemptions. Please note that until you're logged in you will only be able to view the public booking dates.

TICKET TERMS

For most performances, you can book up to four BFI Southbank tickets and up to two BFI Festivals tickets unless otherwise stated. BFI Festival tickets are not transferable or refundable and cannot be exchanged for credit. BFI Champions and Members can exchange BFI Southbank tickets for credit, redeemable against ticket bookings within 12 months, as long as tickets are returned 24 hours ahead of the performance. The BFI is a registered charity and most tickets include an optional 10% donation e.g. a £10.10 Gift Aid ticket includes a donation of 95p. You don't need to be a UK tax payer to buy a Gift Aid ticket but if you are, and you sign a Gift Aid Declaration, the BFI can also claim an extra £2.52 at no extra cost to you.
